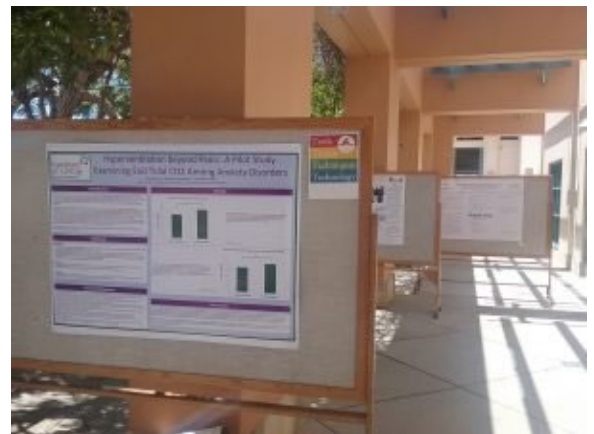

Presenting a poster at the BIOPAC 4T|Phys Conference helps justify the time and cost for you to attend the conference. Gain Recognition

All posters will be displayed for attendees, exhibitors, and presenters to see in the conference central viewing area. This area is co-located with the technology showcase and morning/afternoon refreshment area, so a high level of traffic is ensured. Posters are also open during lunch breaks.



How to Submit a Poster

Any registered 4T|Phys Conference attendee may present a poster. Posters should be landscape orientation, with maximum dimensions of 48 inches wide (3 feet) x 36 inches high (4 feet). Please note: all posters are subject to approval by 4T|Phys conference organizers. Only one poster presentation is allowed per registered attendee/author.

Meet the deadline: **June 6, 2025**
